- T1, sycamore with extensive decay and evidence of polyporus squamosus. Propose reducing height by approximately 50% of its current full height to minimise the risk of stem failure.
- T2, cherry. Branch encroaching on lane being struck by delivery vehicles. Propose pruning branch 1.5m clear of lane.
- T3, holly. Propose 2m crown lift to allow access to graves for grounds maintenance workers.
